Daily/Weekly

- Reading: please ensure your child is reading for at least 30 minutes a day. An additional reading based activity might be completing a reading river, designing an alternative book cover or creating a book themed quiz (with answers). If they read a book from home, please record that in their reading record so that they can attempt a quiz, if there is one.
- Spellings: The children will have a set of 10 spellings each week to learn. These will be given out on the Friday to be tested the following Friday.
- Mathematics: the children will have three Mathematics tasks each week which will be set each half term.

Topic Related Activities

We would like you to complete at least 3 of these (but you can do more!)

- Research how to write their name in Japanese writing.
- Learn how to count to 10 in Japanese.
- Learn how to greet someone in Japanese.
- Investigate sushi - what would a selection of their favourites include?
- What other Japanese food is there?
- Create a word search of topic based words.
- Create a cherry blossom picture. Why is it important to the Japanese?
- Design a kimono with reasons for their choices - can they link these to some of the 7 Visual Elements of Art - colour, tone, line, shape, pattern, texture, form.
- Can they master a new origami creation (bring in instructions to help others create the same model).
- Find out about a Japanese tradition and present details to the rest of the class.
- Create a labelled model of a volcano.
- What can they find out about Sumo wrestling?
- What technology is Japan well known for?
