### Art/DT

In DT, we will be making a vehicle using junk modelling. We will also be creating some whale-inspired pieces of art.

### RE

In RE, we will begin to learn about the Jewish faith and what is important to Jewish people.

### Computing

In computing, we will be thinking about simple coding and how to give a computer instructions.

### PE

We will be learning to participate in team games, developing simple tactics for attacking and defending. We will be practicing throwing, rolling, catching and kicking in different ways.

## Topic: Up, Up and Away

### Maths

In maths, we will start to think about grouping and sharing. We will then find out how to find a half and a quarter. We will also learn to tell time to the hour and half past.

### Music

In Music, we will be listening to and appraising a variety of pop songs.

### PSHE

We will be thinking about how to maintain a healthy lifestyle. This would include thinking about healthy eating and physical activity. Later in the term, we will be thinking about our amazing bodies and how to keep them clean.

### Topic (History and Geography)

In Topic, we will be learning about different methods of transport and how they have changed throughout history.

### Science

We will be learning to identify and name a variety of wild and common plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees. We will also be describing their basic structure.

### English

We start this term with 'The Storm Whale' by Benji Davis. We will then explore non-fiction writing about whales and their journeys.

After half-term, we will be creating our own narratives inspired by texts we have read.
