## A love of learning

I have spent a lot of time in classrooms and outside at playtimes/lunchtimes over the past fortnight and I have been very impressed by what I have seen. We are so lucky here at The Bellbird to have children who are polite and friendly, well behaved and who clearly love their learning. A big thank you to all the teachers for planning such interesting topics for our children to enjoy. Let's hear what they've all been up to...

<u>Reception</u> have settled back in wonderfully after the Easter holiday. They have been investigating the signs of Spring by drawing spring blossom and flowers, making alarm clocks to wake up the hibernating animals and writing invitations to the birds to come and stay in the soft nests that they have made.

<u>Year 1 and 3</u> have had an exciting visit this week! On Tuesday, Kid's Country came into school to deliver the 'Grow Your Own Produce' event. The children participated in 4 activities: they each planted a potato which we will harvest before the end of the school year, and a lettuce plug to take home, learnt about healthy eating, collectively completed an eat well plate jigsaw and finally they learnt about tractors. I'm sure none of you missed the bright yellow tractor parked in front of the school! [all photos are from this event]

Year 2 have just started 'Project Britain'. They have had great fun looking at atlases and finding locations on a map. Some of the children have talked about either visiting Grandparents in Scotland, Wales or Northern Ireland or going on holiday there. Year 4 have been thoroughly immersed in a new poetry text for English, Cherry Moon, a gorgeous collection of poems about nature written by Zaro Weil and beautifully illustrated by Junli Song. In particular, 'Elephant Tusks' has inspired a passion for animal conservation. Some children are even forming a committee to come up with fundraising ideas so they can sponsor an elephant though WWF.

Year 5 have been stepping into "The Ring of Fire" and exploring all things Japanese, including a tour of the islands and creating their own "Space Invader" animated sprites!"

<u>Year 6</u> have enjoyed writing their own 'Choose your own adventure' stories set in the Amazon Rainforest. They have also been learning about how a foetus grows in Science and were excited to discover that an elephant is pregnant for nearly two years! This week they have been 'exploring' Sawston using Google maps as part of our local area topic.
