Daily / Weekly

- **Mathletics:** weekly tasks are set to support the learning we are doing in class (Mathletics).

Topic related activities

We would like you to complete at least 3 of these (but you can do more!)

- Read "Stig of the Dump" by Clive King.
- Read "Ug" by Raymond Briggs.
- Research The Stone Age. Write down any new facts you have learnt and bring them in to share with the class.
- Make a model of Stonehenge.
- Mix up your own Stone Age paint and create some cave art.
- Make a Stone Age pot or necklace and have a Stone Age feast.
- Create a simple Stone Age quiz.
- Find out about the Neolithic village of Skara Brae, create a poster to show what you have learnt.
- Do some prehistoric cooking: baked salmon, grilled trout and berry pudding.
- Create a Stone Age timeline.
- Find out about "Stonehenge Village" and present what you have found out.
- Make a fact file about Stone Age tools.
- Write a diary as a Stone Age child.
- Write a story based in the Stone Age, Bronze Age or Iron Age.
- Create a percussion instrument out of everyday objects.
- Bring in some rocks/fossils that you can tell us about e.g. type of rock/where it comes from etc.
