
Daily / Weekly

Topic related activities

We would like you to complete at least 3 of these (but you can do more!)

Write a <u>diary entry</u> recounting a day in the life of a tribal child.	<u>Paint a picture</u> of a rainforest creature.	Compare a forest in the UK to the Amazon Forest. Amazon/Sherwood Forest
<u>Plants</u> Explain the importance of temperature, light, water and soil for the growth of plants in a rainforest.	Where in the world are there Rainforests?	<u>Who lives where?</u> Which layer of the rainforest do you find different creatures in? (Emergent, canopy, understory, forest floor)
<u>Write a fact sheet</u> on a Rainforest animal.	<u>Plants</u> Create a detailed diagram to explain the life cycle of a flowering plant.	<u>Why does the Rainforest need protecting?</u> Write a newspaper article persuading the public to take positive actions to protect the world's rainforests.
<u>Create a model</u> of the four different layers of the rainforest. 	<u>Predators and Prey</u> Draw a food chain that shows how the animals and plants need one another for their survival.	Explore the different ways in which humans are damaging rainforests, and how that affects the health of the planet.
