#### PE:

### English:

The children will be completing writing tasks based on Jack and the Baked Beanstalk. They will be using a range of adjectives to describe people and places and they will be using conjunctions such as and, but, because and so to join their ideas. They will be expected to apply their knowledge of spellings to all of their writing.

Later in the term, we will start to read Meerkat Mail by Emily Gravett and we will be completing a range of writing tasks linked to this book.

We will be continuing to link our writing to our science and topic work. As well as stories and poems the children will be writing instructions, letters, postcards, explanations and recounts.

#### Science:

We will be completing our plant topic by planting broad bean seeds. We hope to harvest these before the summer holidays.

We will then start our new topic 'living things and their habitats'. The children will be learning that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited. They will be learning about how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants. We will also have a look at food chains.

For some weeks, scientific vocabulary linked to these topics will be included in the weekly spotlight word lists.
