Weekly Home Learning Tasks

Art and DT


We will be doing our first Food and Nutrition unit this term. If you do any cooking or baking at home can you write the recipe of what you made.

Take photographs of your dish or draw a picture of what you made.


Handwriting- Complete these tasks to improve your handwriting skills.
