Art

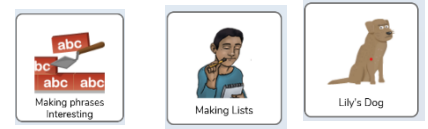
Fine motor skills – Practise cutting along straight and curved lines using paper and card of various thickness.
