We are delighted to inform you that we have registered for Pets As Therapy visits, which can help to give pupils opportunities to increase their confidence and sense of well-being. Every Wednesday, starting on the 4th December, Tilly, a 10-year-old Labrador who has passed her therapy training with flying colours, will be in school for an hour working alongside children.

We have space for a small number of pupils to participate in the visits and, if we feel your child might benefit from such an experience, we will correspond with you directly to gain consent. Tilly will work under the close supervision of the PAT Dog's owner, Sue, and a member of the school staff. Tilly will remain on the lead and under control at all times. A member of school staff will lead the sessions and will be present throughout.

We are so pleased to welcome Sue and Tilly to our school community.
