We will have time to show these every week, usually on a Friday. Have fun!</p>	<p><u>Weekly Home Learning Tasks</u></p> <p><u>Reading</u> – read for 10 minutes every day. <u>Spelling</u> – learn your spelling words for a spelling quiz every Friday. <u>Maths</u> – look for numbers in your environment, count everyday objects and learn your number bonds to 10.</p>	<p><u>English</u></p> <p>In English we will be writing a range of labels, lists and recipes. At home, you can practise this by helping write a weekly shopping list, labelling your toys or writing a recipe you have made.</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>Go on a walk and spot different animals. Talk about how they look different. Does it have wings? Fur? Scales? See if you can identify which group it belongs to. Is it a mammal, amphibian, reptile, bird, insect or fish?</p> <p>Cut out animal and plant pictures from magazines. Sort them into groups. Can you add some labels?</p>
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<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Use the link below for the Top Marks maths site to practise your number bonds to 10.</p> <p>Hit the Button - Quick fire maths practise for 6-11 year olds (topmarks.co.uk)</p>	<p><u>Geography</u></p> <p>Draw a picture of your house. What rooms are in your house?</p> <p>With an adult, see if you can use Google Maps to find your house. What do you notice? What other things can you see?</p>	<p><u>History</u></p> <p>Discuss special memories at home. Can you remember any important events that have happened? This could be a birthday, somebody being born, a wedding or starting school. You might want to send in photographs or draw a picture of this memory to share with the class.</p>	<p><u>Art and DT</u></p> <p>Can you build a stable structure using objects at home? How tall can you make your structure? How are you making sure it is stable? You can email a photograph of your structure to share with the class.</p> <p>Do you know of any interesting buildings?</p>


