Science

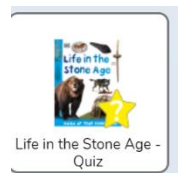
- Bring in some rocks or fossils we may not have seen before. Make sure you know the name of the rock, where it comes from and how it might be used.
